01. Information we collect

We collect information you provide directly, including:

- Account details — name, email address, company, and role (client or partner).
- Consultation bookings — selected service, date, time, and any notes.
- Partner applications — expertise, experience, links, and messages.

- SafeME records — business communications you capture (email, meeting, call, chat, note) with metadata.

We also collect limited technical data (such as log data) needed to operate and secure the service.

02. How we use information

- To create and manage your account and authenticate your sessions.
- To schedule and confirm consultations and process partner applications.
- To provide SafeME features, including AI-assisted risk scoring, summaries, and briefings.
- To send transactional emails (confirmations, status updates, notifications).
- To respond to inquiries and improve our services.

03. Email communications

We send transactional emails related to your bookings and applications. Any marketing emails will include an unsubscribe option and our postal address, in accordance with the CAN-SPAM Act.

04. Data storage & security

Passwords are encrypted, and sessions use signed tokens. As a cybersecurity consulting firm, we apply industry practices to safeguard data. No method of transmission or storage is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

05. Your rights & choices
